As you may be aware the Government have announced that they are putting in National financial support for Early Years and Out of School providers which they are calling “Wraparound Care” to support childcare providers starting from April 2024 till 2026.

This support is to help families with childcare if they were to go back to employment or continue to work or to develop their careers. (please see our website for more information)

On 15.03.2023 the Chancellor of the Exchequer announced extended childcare offer for working parents from 9 months old.

- From **April 2024**, eligible working parents in England with children aged 2 will have access to 15 hours childcare.
- From **September 2024**, the 15 hours childcare offer will be expanded to eligible working parents in England with children between 9 and 23 months old.
- From **September 2025**, eligible working parents in England with children between 9 months and up to school age will have access to 30 hours childcare.
- **Support is also expanding for primary school children from September** parents are expected see and expansion in the availability of childcare in their local area for before and afterschool between 8.00am and 6.00pm also known as “wraparound care”.
